Easy Fiction

Louise: the Adventures of a Chicken by Kate DiCamillo

Longing for adventure, intrepid Louise leaves her comfortable nest and goes to sea

Fish School by Nancy Poydar

Charlie tries to educate his pet goldfish by taking him to school and to the aquarium on a class trip. Includes tips on the care and feeding of goldfish.

Easy Nonfiction

Mermaid Queen by Shana Corey (E BIO KELLERMAN)

An easy biography of British swimmer and social reformer Annette Kellerman.

In the Swim by Douglas Florian (E811 Florian)

A collection of humorous poems about such underwater creatures as the starfish, piranha, and clam.

Mike Fink: A Tall Tale by Steven Kellogg (E398.2 Kellogg)

Relates the extraordinary deeds of the frontiersman who became King of the Keelboatmen on the Mississippi River.

J Fiction

Bad Kitty Gets a Bath by Nick Bruel

Takes a humorous look at the normal way cats bathe, why it is inappropriate for humans to bathe that way, and the challenges of trying to give a cat a real bath with soap and water.

Horrible Harry Goes To Sea by Suzy Kline

The students in Miss Mickle's third-grade class enjoy a boat trip on the Connecticut River after a class discussion of ancestors reveal that Sidney and Ida both have connections to the sea.

Judy Moody & Stink: The Mad, Mad, Mad, Mad Treasure Hunt by Megan McDonald

During a weekend trip to Ocracoke Island, siblings Judy and Stink Moody take part in a pirate treasure-hunting game, in which various clues lead them to silver coins, or "pieces of eight," hidden across the island.

Mokie and Bik by Wendy Orr

For two rambunctious twins, living on a boat means always being underfoot or overboard.
