Easy Nonfiction

Provides a top-to-bottom look at the ocean, from birds and waves to thermal vents and ooze.

Song of the Water Boatman by Joyce Sidman (E811 Sidman)

A collection of poems that provide a look at some of the animals, insects, and plants that are found in ponds, with accompanying information about each.

An exciting picture book biography that introduces young readers to Jacques Cousteau, the world's ambassador of the oceans.
